The number 10 had always been important to her husband. She saw the stray dimes as a sign of his presence and began to collect them. The more she looked, the more she found.

We find what we look for. Thanksgiving is a choice. Joy is a choice.

We begin every Session meeting at the church with five minutes of "joys" from the previous month. It's a way to remind ourselves of all the things that God is doing in our midst. It sets the tone for the meeting. It readjusts our attitude.

I encourage each of us to do the same. Stop and reflect on the good that God is doing and be grateful.


