Dear Brothers and Sisters in The Lord,

Warm greetings to you all from Mzuzu, Malawi, We are all fine here regardless of the Covid19 Pandemic which is still serious in some towns of Malawi. I am writing to officially inform you that the Malawi Government has appointed me as the new Ambassador to Brazil, South America. If all logistics can be over I am supposed to go in January of 2022, with my wife Ruth. This means that the CCAP Synod of Livingstonia shall have to second me to go and work in Brazil and again the Synod shall have to appoint another Principal of Ekwendeni Campus, University of Livingstonia.

However, my daughter Lusekelo Nyondo who is Headmistress and Administrator at Kileni Private School shall continue with the role of looking after Kileni School;, Kileni Women Craft Teamand the distribution of all materials we sometimes get from you friends through the Bana Box container or containers from PCI. All the work of distribution to the needy shall be in her hands.

A new group is forming to provide a safe place for area teens to explore their uniqueness as created and loved by God. First Presbyterian is happy to offer space for this new group. The first vision for this group came from the story of a young gay man who has experienced bullying in an area school and rejection by his local church. 


